LARGER SCREENING TREES/SHRUBS

Plagianthus regius

Pittosporum tenuifolium

Cordyline australis / Cabbage tree

Griselinia littoralis

SMALLER SCREENING SHRUBS/BUSHES

Coprosma propinqua

Astroderia richardii / toetoe

Phormium tenax /swamp flax

Leptospermum scoparium / Manuka. Can be fickle

Hebe salicifolia

Coprosma rugosa in damper places

Olearia species - different species suit different conditions - can be slower growing

Others which will do well in specific sites

Tall: Mountain beech - suits dryer, shallow soils, will need side trimming if in a shelter belt

Podocarpus lateus / totara - slower, suits damper conditions

Medium: Aristotelia serrata / wineberry - frost tender

Carpodetus / marbleleaf - frost tender

Native species, such as Mtn beech, should not be affected if planted straight into soil that has had conifers. Further info at wildingpines.nz
